





This work is an interpretation of Albrecht Drürer's etching Melancholia. It is a self portrait as well as an imagined 'demon' of melancholia. The lightness and brightness of the cat himself suggests a lightness of the presence of depression that sits in the background of my mind. The cat has a sympathetic expression as it is bearing an orb of knowledge and sadness which he invites you to explore and learn from. He takes you on a dark journey but offers a reward of growth. The ball and cat are swarmed by a sea of forget me nots that are a symbol of remembrance and people who have passed. The flowers are also toxic to cats.











They live in painfully heternormative family units comprising a single breeding pair and two generations of their offspring. These groups inhabit homes known as 'dreys', where they remain protected from Melbourne's erratic weather throughout the seasons.






Take the backroad by Sarah Randall Oil on board framed 12 x 14.5cm \$450




